**Q6- What is meant by “Salah” ? List the Three types of Salah giving an example of each type.**

**Salah is ...** the hallmark of a Muslim. It is the key to heaven and binding upon Muslims to offer Salah five times a day. Salah is the second pillar of Islam. (2 Marks)

1- .... Al-Fard: They are the five daily prayers that everyone must pray. Failure to observe any one of the five daily obligatory prayers is a serious sin. (2 Marks)

**Example:.....**Fajr, Thuhr, A’sr, Maghrib or Isha. (1 Mark) (Any one is correct)

2- ... Ar-Rawatib, which are those emphasized and strongly recommended by the Prophet, who was offering them regularly before and after Fard Prayers. (2 Marks)

**Example:.** Before Fajr, Before Thuhr, After Maghrib or After Isha. (1 Mark) (Any one is correct)

3- ... An-Nawafil, which are optional Prayers offered by Muslims at any time in addition to the required ones. (2 Marks)

**Example:.** Al-Tahajjud, Tahiyatul Masjid, Ad-Duha or Witr. (1 Mark) (Any one is correct)

- 1) **An-Niyyah (النِّيَّة):** Is the intention to do something from our hearts. All our actions will be judged by it.
- 2) **At-Taharah (الطَّهَّارَة):** is the purity of the body, clothes and place.
- 3) **Covering parts of the body:** means before offering Salah you should see that you are properly dressed and specific parts of the body are well covered.
- 4) **Wudu':** Before we can offer Salah, we must be clean and pure and must be wash certain parts of our body also Salah cannot be offered without Wudu' it will not counted without it.
- 5) **Facing the Qiblah:** means pointing your face to the direction of Ka'bah where Al-Masjed Al-Haram is located in Makkah.
- 6) **Performing it on time:** means each salah must be offered on time or during its permitted period of time.

The punishment was a big shout accompanied by a great earthquake that destroyed the city and killed all non-believers. (2 Marks)

5- What does Cheating (الغش) mean? why did Prophet Muhammed (ﷺ) scold the trader publicly in the market place? (4 Marks)

**Cheating** means to deceitfully take something that belongs to someone else.

**Because** a trader's goods had gotten wet the previous night due to rainfall. The Prophet accordingly scolded him, by telling him that he should have let people know exactly what he was selling and try not to cheat them by hiding the damaged goods on the bottom of the pile of his goods.
