

Terms and Conditions

Babylon Academy is your local community school with a dedicated staff that aims to provide high standard education in a comfortable and enjoyable environment. Please read through the following information about our enrolment procedure and teaching program:

1. Our aim is to maintain a safe and purposeful atmosphere for everyone regardless of their, religious or ethnicity according to the Equality Act 2010.
2. Students who have some knowledge of Arabic language may be required to take a simple diagnosis assessment to assess their knowledge and abilities that are helpful in allocating them to the most appropriate class. It covers all core skills of Arabic language (i.e. reading, writing and speaking).
3. Our tuition fees are **£460** per child, with a discount of **£20** for each additional child (i. e. **£440** for each additional child) for the whole year (September to June) including the cost of all curriculum books and stationery on the condition that the children are siblings (proof of ID may be required).
4. In specific circumstances, the amount can be paid in 2 installments **ONLY for families with more than one child**, (£300 for each child is payable on the enrolment day and the rest has to be paid before the end of December). This is to secure your child's place for the following term. In such cases, there will be **£30 extra** on the top of the fees. Failure to pay the final instalment on time, the student may be removed from the school register and may be replaced by another candidate from the waiting list or newly registered students.
5. All students are expected to attend all classes regularly for their maximum achievements and success unless there is an emergency, in which case the school should be notified in advance either by email or SMS sent to the school mobile number, to register the student as absent with permission (this must be **before 10 am** on the school day).
6. For the syllabus and curriculum requirements, students are required to participate actively in their classes and always carry out any homework tasks they are given.
7. We expect and highly appreciate all parent's co-operation with us by encouraging their children to fulfil their work continuously as we share the same aims for our students to attain their goals efficiently and successfully.
8. We prepare and plan for our teaching programs in advance, however in some cases that are out of our control, like severe weather, pandemics etc, we reserve the right to reschedule or cancel any school days. In such cases, parents shall be informed in writing.
9. There will be breaks according to some state holidays and occasions, half-terms as well as the main Islamic religious occasions which are shown in our school diary. For any changes, parents/guardians shall be informed.
10. All parents are welcome to visit our school at any time during school Sundays between 10 am and 2 pm. Also, information can be given by phone or email (**preferably**) at any time of the week by our administration department or by visiting our school website at **www.babylonacademy.org**
11. All students are required to attend school about 10 minutes before their first lesson starts and they should be collected by the parents at the end of school with no delay unless there is a serious reason in which case, they are expected to inform our office. However, it should be remembered that the school site has to be evacuated at 3 pm.
12. For parents who are willing to permit their children to walk home by themselves, a written and signed permission is required from the parents to take the responsibility for their children safety and security.
13. Bullying, abusive language or aggressive behaviour (including verbal abuse) will not be tolerated and the school reserves the right to expel any student from school in case our discipline scheme did not lead to a resolution. In such a case, no refund will be made for any losses or paid fees. Also due to our school beforehand financial commitments, **no refund of any paid fees can be offered** at any time after enrolment for any reasons.
14. We might picture some of our school events and activities that might be used later to promote our school activities or published on our website or school page on Facebook or twitter. If you have any concerns about this and prefer your child to not be pictured, please inform us by writing.
15. To avoid any inconvenience, students are advised not to bring any jewellery or valuable things to the school. The school shall not take any responsibility for any damage or loss to those items.
